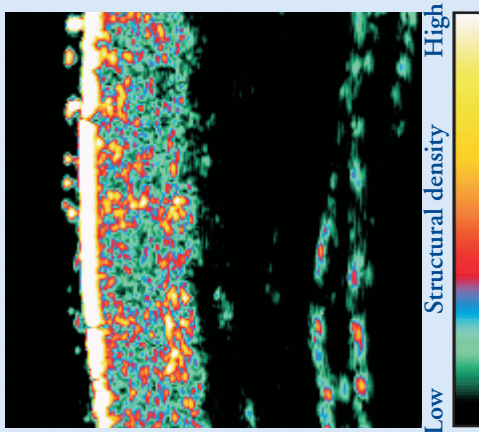
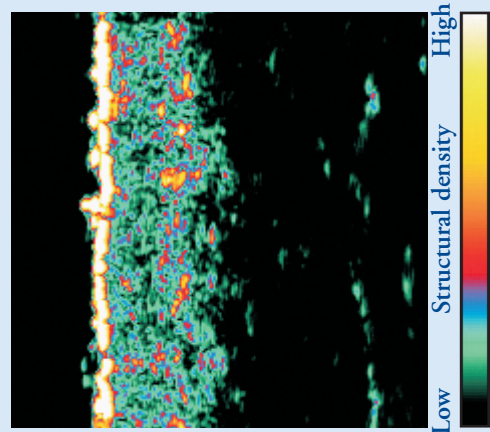

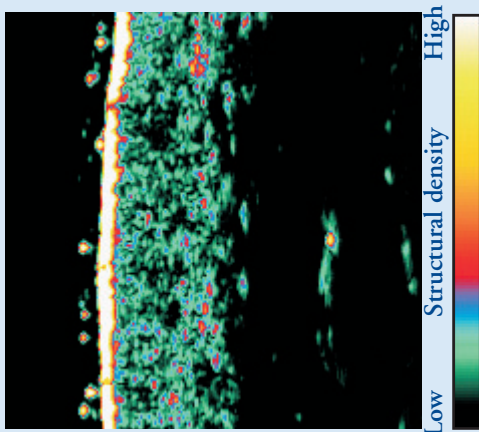
Typical examples of age determined degeneration of the skin's elastic fibre structures. Note that solely chronological degeneration is without accentuated subepidermally layered sun damage.



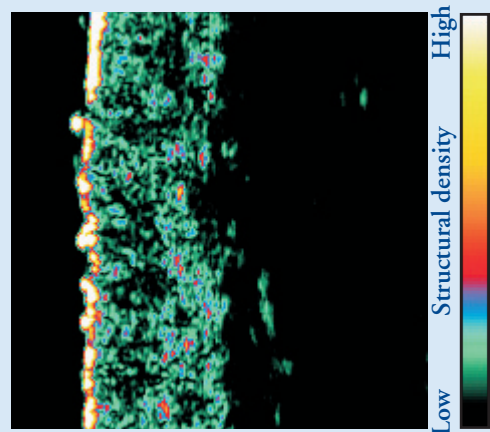
Typical intact fibre structure of a 20 year old female (left temple)
